Culinary Discovery

Travel and fine food go together

While this itinerary is not one of our 'Foodie'-themed journeys, we do believe that each one of our journeys should introduce you not only to hidden gems of cultural and scenic beauty, but that sampling local cuisines is also a must.

Wherever you travel with us, we will order, with very few exceptions, dishes fresh and on location with an emphasis on local produce. It is not uncommon for our guides to venture into the kitchen to pick this, that or the other vegetable and to ask the cook to prepare them in the finest possible way. Arrive in Phnom Penh per your own arrangements. We will pick you up from the airport and take you to your hotel. You will have the remainder of the afternoon free to explore Cambodia's capital – join shoppers in the lively Central Market, stroll along Sisowath Quay or visit the Royal Palace.

In the evening we will meet for a welcome dinner and road safety briefing.

DAY 2 AN UNIQUE EXPERIENCE IN A SMALL MUSLIM COMMUNITY ON THE MEKONG

Our first driving day takes us to Chhlong, a small town on the Mekong, 200km (5hrs driving time) northeast of Phnom Penh. We will make a few interesting stops along the way, including an insect market for snacking. In the late afternoon we arrive at our destination for today. Once a bustling port for French and Chinese traders, today decaying colonial- era villas line the streets.

This region is home to the Cham people, a Muslim community living alongside the Buddhist Khmers – you might spot village mosques on today's drive. After arriving, you can enjoy the hotel grounds.

In the evening we will enjoy a dinner at the hotel.

DAY 3 IN AND AROUND CHHLONG

Today we explore the area around Chhlong and drive 1 hour further North towards Kratie. Here we continue with a boat excursion on the mighty Mekong River, where we were granted the unique opportunity to witness the Mekong Dolphins in their natural habitat. Thanks to the concerted efforts of Cambodia and various non-governmental organizations, these endangered creatures have made a remarkable comeback.

After a local lunch we embark on a leisurely drive back towards Chhlong, taking the opportunity to visit the captivating temples spread throughout the area. Each temple exuded a unique charm, showcasing the intricate artistry and spiritual significance that resonates within Cambodia's rich history.

As the evening sets in, indulge in another delightful dinner at the hotel, enjoying traditional Khmer dishes prepared with locally sourced ingredients.

DAY 4 ALONG THE MEKONG TO SIEM REAP

We leave Chhlong early today and take a car ferry across the Mekong. Our way leads us slowly away from the Mekong through rubber tree plantations and small villages. Lunch will be a local affair along the way towards Siem Reap. The road towards Siem Reap might be a bit busier, time permitting we make a stop at the fishermen's village Kampong Khleang. A traditional stilted village community found living high above the lake's waters and the village provides homes for some 20,000 residents - it is the largest single community on the fringes of the Tonle Sap Lake. Then we make our way to Siem Reap and our hotel for the next two nights.

DAY 5 THE ARTS AND ANGKOR

As the base for visiting Angkor Wat, Siem Reap is one of the most famous destinations in Cambodia. Angkor itself is one of the most important archaeological sites in Southeast Asia. It extends over approximately 400 square kilometres and consists of scores of temples and hydraulic structures (basins, dykes, reservoirs, canals).

Although the entire site is known as Angkor Wat, the name actually refers to a single large temple within the Angkor region.

For several centuries Angkor was the centre of the Khmer Kingdom. Temples such as Angkor Wat, the Bayon, Preah Khan and Ta Prohm are the finest existing examples of Khmer architecture.

Angkor was intended as an earthly representation of Mount Meru, the Mount Olympus of the Hindu and Buddhist faiths. Khmer kings each strove to better their ancestors, a process that culminated in Suryavarman II's (r 1112-52) construction of Angkor Wat, the world's largest religious building.

There is much to see in Angkor. We will start the day early, and watch sunrise over the temples. Thereafter, you can arrange the day as you wish; explore as much of Angkor as possible, or relax at the hotel through the heat of the day, and head out again in the evening. Whatever you would like to do, our team will do their best to help you realise your plans.

DAY 6 BATS AND COLONIAL BATTAMBANG

After a leisurely morning we depart for Battambang. With a rich architectural heritage, a thriving art scene, and stunning surrounding countryside, Battambang is a tranquil respite from the hustle and bustle of Phnom Penh and Siem Reap.

The first part of our drive is on a busy road, but then we turn away on a

beautiful country road and soon on some sandy tracks through villages and paddy fields. We arrive in Battambang in the early evening.

Before we check-in into our hotel we will make a stop at the bat cave.

As dusk falls every day at around 5 or 6 pm, thousands upon thousands of these nocturnal creatures leave their nests and pour out of the cave, reminiscent of a smoke column billowing up to the sky. It takes up to 40 minutes for all of the bats to exit, so you'll have plenty of time to take a good photo.

Afterwards we drive to our small boutique hotel, the Maisons Wat Kor.

DAY 7 EXPLORE BATTAMBANG THEN A SHORT DRIVE TO PURSAT

Today we explore the charming city of Battambang, where history, art, and cuisine come together to create a delightful experience. Our leisurely day begins with a delicious breakfast, energizing us for the adventures that await.

We start by visiting an ancient house in the neighborhood, immersing ourselves in Cambodia's rich and sometimes dark history. As we explore, we gain a deeper understanding of the country's past and its impact on the present.

Next, we make our way to the heart of Battambang downtown, where the governor's house awaits. This landmark allows us to witness the grandeur of Cambodian architecture and feel the elegance of the past.

But it's time to indulge in one of Battambang's most renowned features – its cuisine. Despite not boasting any Michelin-starred restaurants, this quiet provincial capital has been recognized by UNESCO as a gastronomical destination. We venture into the local market, with its vibrant colors and enticing aromas, to sample the flavors that make Battambang famous.

As we wander through town, we can't help but be enchanted by the charming colonial-era buildings standing proudly along narrow lanes. The “walking district” near the market comes alive with contemporary art galleries, local and foreign cafes, shops, and bars that have found their home in the old shophouses. It's a treasure trove for art enthusiasts and those seeking a slice of Battambang's vibrant culture. In the later afternoon it is time for our short drive to Pursat, a less charming town but a necessary stop for our long drive to Koh Kong the next day.

Our road eventually leads us to Tatai, where we safely park our cars and embark on a serene sailing journey to the Canvas and Orchids Retreat. Here, amidst the tranquil surroundings, we'll indulge in an extraordinary glamping experience. This private sanctuary provides the perfect setting to unwind and connect with nature.

To conclude this eventful day, we'll savor a delightful dinner at the hotel-owned restaurant. Prepare to be treated to a culinary experience that complements the beauty of our surroundings.
